

Conditions for awarding talent grant

For whom The talent grant is intended for recent graduates (maximum two years after graduation) and students in the graduation phase.

Nomination The application for the talent grant can only take place after nomination by one of the heads of the three master programs in Landscape Architecture in the Netherlands (Wageningen University, Amsterdam Academy of Architecture and MSc track in Landscape Architecture Delft University of Technology).

When The talent grant is an annual grant. The application period closes on December 10, 2020. The decisions about the awards will be made in January 2021.

Judging assessments The assessment of the application and the judging is done by a jury consisting of the board of the NHBOS Foundation supplemented by two landscape architects.

Assessment criteria The quality of the work completed and expectations regarding the development of the work and the applicant's professional practice are assessed. In addition, the work plan of the activities to be undertaken will be examined including how these will contribute to one's own professional development and landscape architecture as a discipline. References will also be taken into account.

Application form The application must be accompanied by a fully completed form with the applicant's personal details supplemented with:

- a cv supported by a portfolio consisting of a visual documentation (max. 10 A4 in total);
- an explanation of the work and / or the developing professional practice, leading to a motivation for the application (max. 5 A4 in total);
- a work plan with planning (max. 10 A4 in total);
- a reference letter from the study program, or from the professor under whose direction the graduation project is/was, or from the (internship) supervisor/employer.

Agreements In a letter from the foundation board, in which the allocation of the talent grant to the applicant is stated, the following agreements are recorded.

Payment in advance The talent grant amounts to € 5,000. Payment takes place immediately after the grant has been awarded, i.e. prior to the activities as stated in the work plan of the recipient of the talent grant.

Product After completion, the recipient of the talent grant will report to the NHBOS Foundation on the activities in a form at its own discretion and appropriate to the character of the activities; the proposal for the format of this report is part of the applicant's work plan.

Presentation The recipient of the talent grant is invited to present the work during the triennial presentation of the Bijhouwerprijs. The content and form of the presentation takes place in consultation with the NHBOS Foundation; the proposal for this is part of the applicant's work plan. Presentation by the recipients of the talent grant will become a permanent part of the presentation of the Bijhouwerprijs.

Dissemination The educational institutes are requested to promote broad attention for both the selection of the applicant and the final result by means of a publication, a presentation or an exhibition.

Mention The recipient of the talent grant mentions in all cases of publication and exhibition the fact that the NHBOS Foundation has made the work possible.

Copyright The recipient of the talent grant continues to hold the copyright of the work produced (both images and models/installations). In consultation with the NHBOS Foundation, prior to publications and the presentation during the presentation of the Bijhouwerprijs, agreements are made about the publication of the work produced by the recipient of the talent grant.
